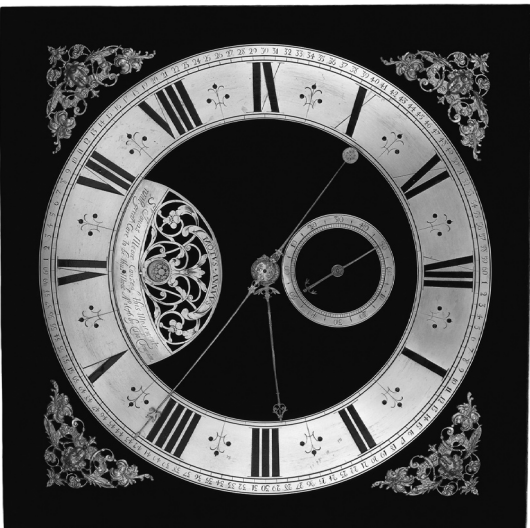

1. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the charity
